Dear Learners,

** First-time full-time undergraduate learners refers to learners who are attending college for the first time and are enrolled full time, who are a subset of the general learner population. Among non-first-time, full-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates, completion rates reach up to 85% within 8 years (IPEDS Outcome Measures, 2016–17 entry cohort; non-first-time full-time students; non-Pell recipients).
