

BDN Program Outcomes Benchmarks Insert

The program Outcomes are combined into five (5) mission-based broad categories as follows:

Educational Success-Learners

- 90% of learner population will meet SAP.
- 90% of learners will complete the Program.
- Less than 5% of matriculated learners will withdraw from the Program within the first two (2) weeks of instruction.
- Net Promoter Index (NPI) of the learner satisfaction surveys will be positive.
- 80% of learners will meet the Level Three (3) experiential benchmarks based on the NUR 260 benchmark assignment and simulation.
- 80% of Level I learners will meet the Level I program outcomes.
- 80% of Level II learners will meet the Level II program outcomes.
- 80% of Level III learners will meet the Level III program outcomes.
- 80% of Level IV learners will meet the Level IV program outcomes
- 80% of Level V learners will meet the Level V program outcomes
- 80% of Level VI learners will meet the Level VI program outcomes
- 80% of Level VII learners will meet the Level VII program outcomes

Educational Success-Graduates

- 90% of graduating learners will meet the Level VII learning outcomes benchmark
- 85% of graduating learners will meet the Level Six (6) experiential benchmarks based on the NUR 360 benchmark assignment and simulation.
- 20% of alumni will be enrolled in or completed a higher degree nursing program within 24 months after graduation.
- The one (1) year rolling first-time NCLEX-RN® exam pass rate will be above 80%.
- The overall licensure rate will be above 90% for the preceding three (3) calendar years.

Professional Success-Learners

- 25% of learners will be actively involved in other nursing associations.
- 100% of learners will be employed in professional nursing roles.

Professional Success-Graduates

- Three-year cohort default rate will be less than 15%.
- 75% of alumni who graduated during the last academic year will be employed in the nursing field by December 1.
- The Net Promoter Index (NPI) of the employer surveys will be positive.
- The Net Promoter Index (NPI) of the alumni surveys will be positive.

Improving the Communities We Serve

- 75% of learners will participate in volunteer activities at least once during program enrollment.
- 75% of learners will participate in the Community Health Intervention Project over the course of the program.
- 100% of learners will create population-based proposals and capstones, which emphasize health promotion, disease prevention or chronic disease management.
